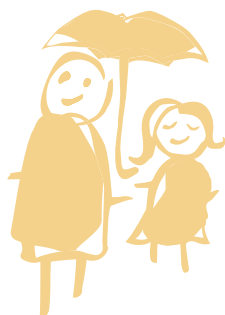

The service currently offers consultation with Occupational Therapy (OT) and Physiotherapy (PT) and operates within a community-based framework and offers a range of supports.

The aim is to provide:

-  Information
-  Education
-  Assistance and Support

On such areas as:

-  Positioning and handling of children
-  Advice and prescription for equipment such as bathing aids, seating, splinting, transportation and other specialized equipment
-  Write letters and reports as may be necessary for and on behalf of children and families
-  Manual handling for care givers
-  Provide advice, reports and liaison as may be required with regard to accessibility and home modifications
-  Liaise with therapy services from other agencies
-  Support visits at homes, hospitals and at other locations as may be required
-  Post-operative care
-  Advice on chest physiotherapy, stretching etc.
